Response from the DTI concerning the cost to British Industry from returning holiday illnesses

The DTI have informed us that having reviewed the request, they consider that the question fell within the remit of the Department for Work and Pensions.

Our Correspondence was forwarded to them. They have responded by stating that they do not hold such information and suggested that it was possible that the Department of Health held such information.

We have written to the DTI requesting confirmation that they do not keep any statistical data on the cost to British Industry from returning holiday illnesses.
